Christmas Jumpers:

Children can wear Christmas jumpers instead of school jumpers from Tuesday to Friday.

The Inn Keeper's Breakfast:

Thank you for ordering your tickets for the Robins' and Wrens' production of The Innkeeper's Breakfast. Tickets were given to children on Friday. Shows are at 10am and 2pm. Access to school will only be via the Miller's Close entrance. Please come to the large playground gates for access to the site. The show is being held in the outdoor classroom.

Children will be allowed to leave after the 2pm show if you would like to take them with you once they are changed (we're happy to keep them too though). Older children can also be taken home if this is more convenient for you, but they are doing PE so might want to stay!

Carols on the Playground

Everybody is invited to join in with Hawks and Kingfishers children as they celebrate Christmas and lead the festive singing. All KS2 children need to return to school between 5.15-5.20pm – head to their classrooms to meet their teachers.

Both gates to the school will be open. Please come to the main playground gates to access the playground or the classrooms for the school.

Please dress for the weather – eg Christmas jumpers and coats. The Carols begin at 5.30pm and will be on the back playground. Please bring a torch and your best singing voice!

Please keep younger children with you and do not allow them to play on the playground apparatus as it will be quite dark – thank you. The event is expected to last approximately half an hour.

Christmas Beetle Drive

This is taking place on Thursday from 5-6.30pm. Tickets are £2 per child. Please pay via OPTA bank account (Offord PTA 20-05-73 20176346 using reference Beetle and child's name) or cash via your class teacher. Tickets need to be paid for by end of day on Tuesday. Tickets will be distributed from Monday. The children don't need to bring anything with them, just lots of Christmas cheer. Snacks and drinks will be provided during the evening. Drop off and collection via the hall doors on the playground.
